**Section 1.0**      **Scope**

The Arizona Department of Health Services/Division of Behavioral Health Services (ADHS/DBHS) Provider Manual describes public behavioral health system requirements for any entity that directly provides behavioral health services within Arizona's public behavioral health system. These entities may include:

- Behavioral health providers;
- Regional Behavioral Health Authorities; and
- Tribal Regional Behavioral Health Authorities.

The ADHS/DBHS Provider Manual is applicable to defined populations that may access public behavioral health services. These populations include:

- Title XIX and Title XXI eligible persons;
- Non-Title XIX persons determined to have a serious mental illness; and
- Other populations, based on the availability of funding and the prioritization of available funding.
