Selects, prioritizes, and approves best practices & evidence-based practices for NARBHA. Develops & approves clinical policies and practices. Develops & reviews new clinical program initiatives.

Reviews and approves provider network credentialing and privileging applications and processes. Approves applications for new provider network contracts.
