Methodology

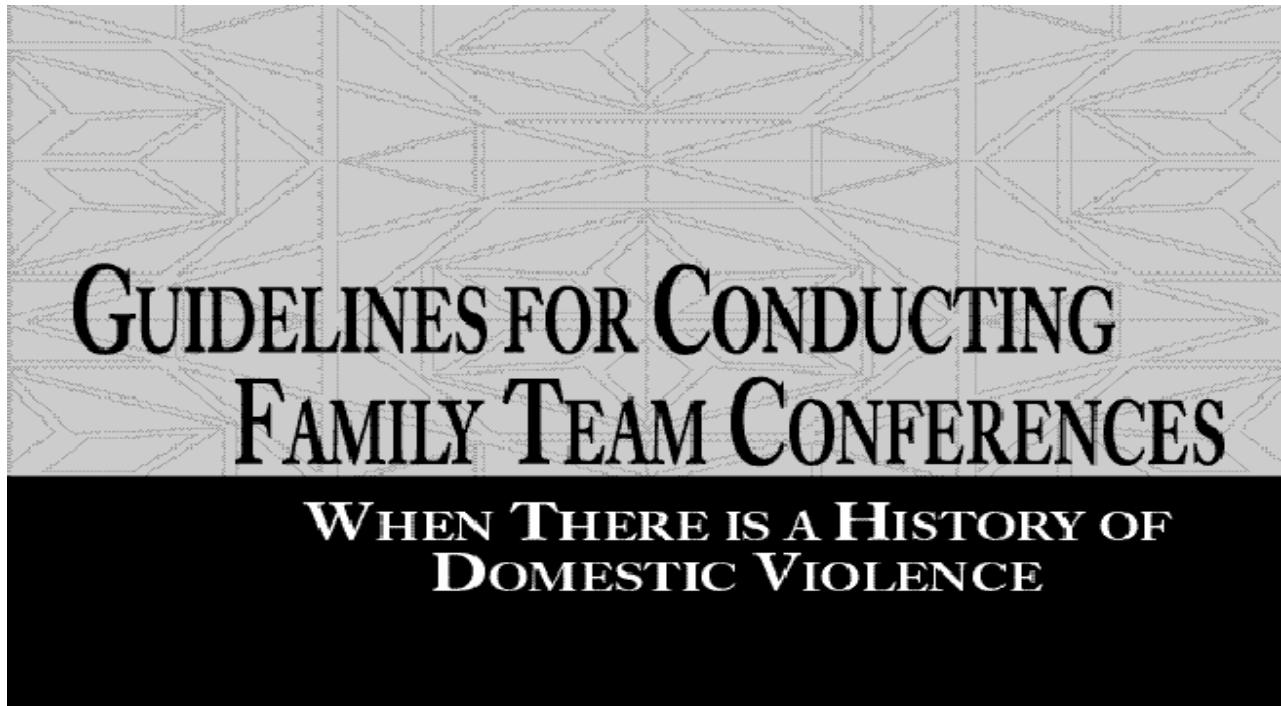
