The Guidance Center Celebrates 40 years of Service!

On Tuesday, May 19, 2009, The Guidance Center (TGC) will celebrate 40 years of providing behavioral health services to the Flagstaff and surrounding communities. TGC offers a full range of high-quality, cost-effective services in both Flagstaff and Williams.

The Guidance Center's mission is "to improve the behavioral health of the people of our community." TGC operates under a contract with Northern Arizona Regional Behavioral Health Authority (NARBHA) and licensure by the ADHS Office Behavioral Health Licensure as an Outpatient Clinic to deliver: Counseling; Title 36 Court Ordered Treatment; Medication Services; DUI Screening; DUI Treatment; and, DUI Educational services. In 2007, TGC opened the Intake Triage Unit which provides detoxification services to adults in the Flagstaff community and surrounding areas in conjunction with Flagstaff Medical Center, Flagstaff Police Department, Guardian Medical Transport and Coconino County Sheriff's Office.

A celebration is scheduled on Tuesday from 4:30-6:30pm in the Indigo Room at Outpatient Office located at 2695 E. Industrial Drive, Flagstaff. Speakers will include: Maurice Miller, former CEO of NARBHA; Dr. Gene Moan, Chair of The Guidance Center's Board of Directors; and, Linda Cowen, CEO of The Guidance Center.
