Office or other outpatient visit for the evaluation and management of an established patient which requires 2 of 3 key components: problem focused history, problem focused examination and medical decision making of varying complexity.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Prolonged Service Time Thresholds</p> <p>99211: Brief outpatient clinic visit of established patient who is seen by non-MD staff and physician is consulted to provide minimal medical decision making about patient management.
